Reading

This half term, I will be looking at playscripts and how

they are read differently to a story book. I will also enjoy reading poetry with a focus on limericks.

Writing

I will be writing a section of a playscript using the features of a playscript to add interest and clarity for the reader. I will write my own limerick

Spoken Language

I will use appropriate intonation, tone and volume to present my writing. I will take on the role of different characters in a play and think carefully about how to convey their character using my voice. I will learn to read my limerick using pause and careful timing.

Geography - Rivers

I am going to learn about what a river is and the main features of a river. I will find out about a local river, the Ribble, a European river, the Tiber and a famous world river, the Nile. I will explore the journey of a river, including the water cycle and learn about the upper, middle and lower courses of the river. I will create a presentation about my findings. I will explore the human impact on rivers and how rivers can have a negative and positive impact on those living near.

PE – Gym Activities

I will be exploring gym activities to develop my flexibility, strength, control, balance and control. I will create a sequence of gymnastic actions including matched shapes and mirrored shapes with a partner. I will then move onto creating a sequence of activities with a partner on the gym apparatus. My sequence will include travel, rolling, balance and jumping and include at least six actions. I will learn to use apparatus to perform jumping and rolling actions with control.

Art - Sculpture

I will plan a 3D model of a character from a familiar story (Fantastic Mr Fox) I will use my sketchbook to plan ideas. I will use clay to make a robust 3D sculpture which conveys the characteristics of my chosen character. I will then use decorative techniques such as paint to add texture and colour to my model before appraising it.


