### Reception

We are beginning to prepare for Christmas! In RE we learned why we have Christmas Day and we know that we celebrate the birth of a VERY special baby. We are becoming familiar with the Nativity story and have loved dressing up as angels, shepherds and kings to retell the story. We are busy learning all the songs and actions for our Nativity performance – thank you for helping us with the words at home.

In Maths we have been looking at numbers to 5 and working out all the different ways we can make them, eg 4+1=5, 3+2=5, 0+5=5.

### Year 1

This week we have had a BIG focus on handwriting, looking at the size of capital and lower-case letters and ensuring that we write on the line.

In Maths we are looking at 3D and 2D shape. We are learning the names and are comparing their different properties. Nativity song practice is in full flow, and your children should now know their character for the play.
