Class News

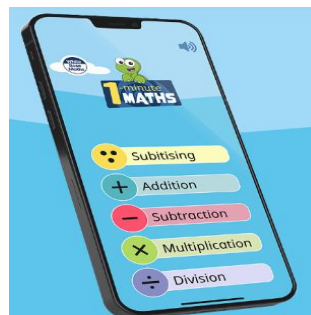
In Year 1...
