### In Class

We are busy writing play-scripts in our English lessons using a lovely silent film called Soar! The children are focusing on using colons, stage directions and scenes to write their own script which they will use for performance once finished. We are concentrating on multiplication and division in Maths; please keep encouraging your children to practise regularly. We have looked at the melting point of different chocolates in Science and have been trying hard to use scientific equipment properly. We have been using scientific vocabulary to describe the changes in state from a solid to a liquid. We wrote some beautiful metaphors for Jesus as the Light of our World in our RE, and this week the children have started to plan out their own artwork to represent this. We have also been starting to learn the songs to our Christmas production.
