

We have had a lovely few weeks in Class 4! We have been continuing our learning, starting a new text in English called "The Firework Maker's Daughter". The children have been enjoying exploring the text and using PEE (point, evidence, explain) in their writing. Ask your child about 'crackle dragons'! In maths, we have started our learning about written multiplication, focussing on the short multiplication method, multiplying Th,H,T,O numbers by ones. In Science, we have been investigating the processes of freezing and melting and how water changes state from a solid to a liquid. In Geography, we have been continuing our work on rivers to study our local river, The River Ribble and famous rivers in Europe.
