Class News

In Year 1...

We are enjoying reading and innovating the story of The Enormous Turnip. This week, we have been exploring different words for enormous, and next week we will be writing our own version of the tale.

In Maths, we are looking at the place value of numbers from 11–20, recognising how many tens and ones each number has and what that means and looks like. We have also started to move from number tracks to number lines.

In Year 2 ...

We have begun sharing the story of 'Aladdin'. We have been looking at film clips of the marketplace and using adjectives to add description in sentences. This week have focused on the character of Aladdin and explored clues about his character from the text.

In Maths we have completed our topic on Shape and explored the properties of 3d shapes and repeating colour and shape patterns. Next week, we will begin our new topic on Money. Please encourage your child to look at real coins and learn about the values of each coin.

In DT we are exploring healthy food options and in our Geography lessons we have begun learning about the continents and oceans. Our topic in RE is Jesus, friend to all and we will be exploring friendships and emotions/feelings in our PSHE lessons.

HOMEWORK and READING BOOKS REMINDER

Please return homework and READING books on MONDAYS. The reading books are used by different groups of children each week and it places another child at a disadvantage if your child's reading book is not returned promptly.

Please read with your child daily to practise the vocabulary and check their understanding of the books they bring home over the weekend. Research shows that those children who talk about books, and read with parents regularly, do significantly better with their learning than those who do not.
