We are learning about mass and capacity in Maths. We have explored how many cubes to put on a balance scale to weigh the same as an object on the other side. We have been filling up containers to make them full, half full, nearly empty and empty. In RE we have learned about Daniel in the Lion's Den and Jonah and the Big Fish and how they listened to God. In Literacy we have been writing captions using the phonemes and tricky words we know. We have retold the story of the Gingerbread Man using the repetitive language from the story. We have looked at a globe and have learned where the equator is. We know that it gets colder the further away we are.
