Last week, we celebrated our Culture Week in school with each class finding out about a significant person from a different culture who had links to our local area. In Class 3 we researched Milena Grenfell Baines, a remarkable Jewish woman who left her home in the Czech Republic at the age of 9 to board the kindertransport, a special rail mission to rescue Jewish children from the Nazis. Milena was responsible for her younger sister and cousin as they travelled across Europe to safety. Milena went on to marry George Grenfell Baines and set up home in Preston. Now, at the ripe old age of 96, she is still encouraging people to show compassion and understanding to refugees who flee their country during war.

This week, we have been looking at times of betrayal and trust in the Easter story. We have continued with our work on fractions in Maths, looking at ordering non-unit fractions as well as working out equivalent fractions using our fraction walls to help us.
