Year 5 made life-long memories together at Borwick Hall this half term - I know Year 4 are excited for their day trip there in the coming weeks!



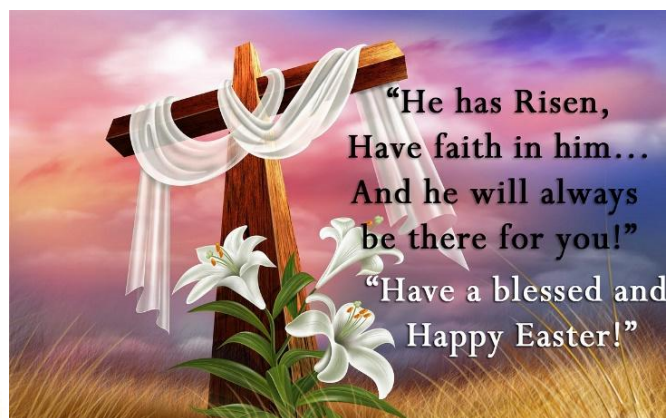
