This half term our PE lessons will be on TUESDAYS.

In Year 1 ...

In English we have been looking at the book, 'The Lion Inside'. We have been extending our vocabulary by exploring adjectives to describe the characters. We have also been extending our sentences by using the joining words 'and' and 'but'.

In Maths we have started Multiplication by looking at counting in 2s, 5's and 10's and exploring the importance of groups being 'equal' when counting in multiples. We have looked at multiplication as repeated addition.

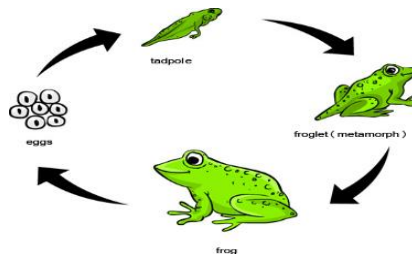
We are excited about our worship next week and hope you can join us on Monday 27th @ 10:40am. All children have lines in their bag to learn, they came home on Wednesday.

In Year 2 ...

This half term we are looking at the Mudpuddle Farm stories by Michael Morpurgo. We have met Mossop and Albertine in our stories and used the suffix _ing and present tense in our writing and sentence work.

In maths we have started a new topic on Fractions and explored halves with shapes and amounts. Next week, we will move on to look at quarters.

In our science lessons, we have looked at animal offspring and life cycles. We have looked at the life cycle of a frog and were very excited to discover we have frog spawn in the school pond. We will be watching closely to see how they grow!



In RE, we have begun exploring the story of the Ascension and shared our thoughts and ideas on what Heaven might be like.

We have also been paper engineering in our DT lesson and making simple pop-ups. Next week, we will begin learning about levers and sliding mechanisms.
