The children have thoroughly enjoyed our Geography learning this term. In RE we have looked at what we might find on the inside of a church. We decorated some beautiful stained glass windows. We will be learning about some places that are special to people from different religious traditions. In Maths we have been performing simple addition by adding more to a group. In Literacy we are looking at 'Would you rather...' by John Burningham and making up our own 'Would you rather...?' questions.

Year 1

In English this week, we have been writing our own stories. The children have displayed their creative imaginations as they have altered the plot of 'The Lion Inside' to create their own story. In Maths, we have been looking at equal and unequal groups. We have been grouping and sharing amounts as an introduction to division. In RE, we have been learning about the miracles of Jesus and thought about how they show us He is the Son of God.
