In Year 1 ...

In English this week, we have been writing our own stories. The children have displayed their creative imaginations as they have altered the plot of 'The Lion Inside' to create their own story.

In Maths, we have been looking at equal and unequal groups. We have been grouping and sharing amounts as an introduction to division.

In Re, we have been learning about the miracles of Jesus and thought about how they show us he is the Son of God. We looked at artwork that retells the story of Feeding the 5000 and used these pictures to inspire our own artwork.

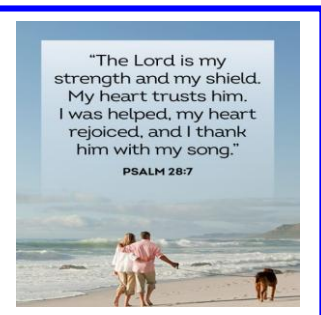
