Here we are then – the final half term for the Year 6 children at Lea Endowed! While learning is continuing in all areas, time is also being put aside to prepare for upcoming events and transition to High School.

It has been good to get stuck into our English writing again where we have been considering whether Fagin (from Oliver Twist) is good, bad or in the middle. The children will present their ideas in the form of a discussion text. We are also completing a mammoth 'Theme Park Maths' project to design, market and run our own theme parks.
