Happy New Year to all! As a class, we have had a superb start to the new year. In English, we have written a recount of our holidays, then edited it and began our unit looking at the Bear Grylls novel 'The Volcano Challenge'. In Maths, we have begun the term looking at the place value of decimal numbers. In RE, we began our unit on singing in worship. The children really enjoyed listening to a range of worship songs and sharing their thoughts. A particular favourite was 'Deep Down' by Lincoln Brewster. In Science, we started our unit on electricity by thinking through what electricity is, then creating a range of circuits; and exploring the 'magic' (as some children called it) of the Energy Stick from Steve Spangler that shows how humans conduct electricity. In Geography, we located the country of Italy, which we will explore in more depth as the half term progresses. In Computing, we began our Powerpoint unit focussing on setting up a presentation effectively. In PE, the Year 5 children went swimming.
