Maths

This week we have been learning different strategies for multiplying numbers. We have been finding out how known facts can help us work out more complex calculations.

<u>English</u>

In English we have continued to read our Class Novel: we have been scanning the text for key information and writing the next part of the story using action, description and dialogue.

In Science we have been finding out about newly discovered species of animal in the world. The children then designed their own species and thought about its adaptations for survival.
