In English we have watched a short film: 'The Piano.' The children have been exploring adventurous vocabulary and writing narratives including flashbacks.

This week we have started reading our new Class Novel: Deep Water by Ann Turnball. We have been retrieving information and finding evidence in the text. In Maths, we have been looking at fractions. The children have been exploring equivalent fractions, simplifying and calculating with fractions and mixed numbers.

In R.E. we have been exploring the Advent Wreath, and finding out about its purpose and meaning. The children led a whole school worship about this on Thursday of this week. We have been discovering more about World War One in History focusing on life in the trenches and propaganda. In D.T. the children have begun making toys as Christmas presents for their reception buddies! The children also enjoyed their Life Education visit where their explored life decisions and making good choices. We have also been busy rehearsing our Christmas show.
