Our Christian Value this week is **Forgiveness.** Why is forgiving others helpful for us as well?

Hello parents and carers,

This week we have been writing independently and focused on comprehension skills and answering questions about a text. In our Maths work this week we have completed arithmetic and reasoning questions, and begun a new topic on mass, using balance scales and comparing heavier and lighter objects.

Next week we will be finding masses using scales and kilograms and grams.

In RE, we have explored the Easter story in detail and sequenced the main events.

In Science, we have been exploring how plastic can be recycled and reused, and sorted a range of materials identifying which can be recycled and which can't. We have also explored the effects of plastics on wildlife in our oceans. REDUCE – REUSE – RECYCLE!
