After the Half Term break, the Year 1s will be taking their Phonics Screening Test. We keep this very low key as we do not want the children to feel under pressure to perform. We have sent home a phonics pack for the children to work through during the holidays so that they are ready for the screening when they come back in June. Reading books have also been sent home.
