LEARNING IN SCHOOL

English: We have started a unit using 'Aladdin and the Magic Lamp' as our source text. We have read many tales told by Sheherazade. We have generated lots of noun phrases and described characters and settings.

Maths: We focussed on the last section of Place Value as well as telling the time in both 12-hour and 24-hour digital time.
