

SCHOOL UNIFORM LIST

All pupils are required to wear school uniform. All uniform must be labelled with child's name.

Boys:

- Grey trousers.
- School royal blue sweatshirt
- Gold / yellow polo shirt
- Black sensible shoes with non-slip soles.
- Black or grey socks.
- Trainers or trainer type shoes should only be worn for games or outside P.E. They are not part of the school uniform.

Girls:

- Grey tunic / grey skirt or grey trousers.
- School royal blue sweatshirt/cardigan
- Gold / yellow polo shirt
- Black **sensible** shoes with non-slip soles. No open toed shoes or sling backs are permitted.
- Trainers should only be worn for games or outside P.E. They are not part of the school uniform.
- Black / grey or white socks or black or grey tights.
- In the summer short-sleeved sky blue or yellow gingham dress

Hair

All hair, longer than collar length, should be tied back, regardless of gender. Hair decoration should be kept simple.

P.E. KIT

- All children should have a white tee shirt,
- navy hoodie / zip-hoodie,
- navy or black plain tracksuit,
- a pair of black pumps/trainers.
- Bare feet is not allowed for lessons in the hall.
- Children having games outside should wear the appropriate kit. Football kits for P.E. are not permitted.
- Children who go swimming must have costume, towel and a bathing cap. A brush or comb should be carried, but no aerosol deodorants or talcum powder.

VALUABLES IN SCHOOL

Valuable or sentimental jewellery should not be worn in school. Any watch worn should be marked with the child's name. Children who have pierced ears should wear small studs for their own protection. Watches and studs should be removed for all games, P.E., dance, movement and swimming activities. If your child cannot remove them they should not be worn on the days when these activities are taking place. **Any other jewellery is strictly forbidden.** Children should not bring toys into school without the Class Teacher's permission.
