## This Week...

We completed our class story, The Owl who was Afraid of the Dark this week and wrote book reviews during our Guided Reading time. The children all really enjoyed the book and are now busy planning their own chapter of the story. They have been using a different planning format called 'chunking' which will lead nicely onto writing in paragraphs next week. We have been adding 1, 10 and 100 to numbers in our Maths and have started to see patterns in our calculations which help us when we are working out an answer mentally rather than writing it down. We are investigating 'thermal conductivity' in Science, testing which material will keep some yogurt frozen for the longest time. We discussed quotes from the Bible in our RE and linked the message from God to our own lives and the lives of others.

Thank you to the parents who attended the Online Safety Meeting on Wednesday. Comments left by parents have been really positive and I am glad you found it useful. As you know, keeping our children safe is our number one priority at Lea Endowed, and an awareness of what the children are accessing/ playing on devices such as tablets is an integral part of this.
