This Week...

In Maths we have been looking at place value; we have been reading, writing and demonstrating our understanding of numbers up to one thousand. In our English lessons we started to read our Class Novel: George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl. We have been describing the characters, looking at the author's choice of language and answering questions about the text. In Geography we have begun our topic about rivers. We have also been thinking about Online Safety in our Computing lesson. Each children wrote a prayer for the new school year in R.E - we have been thanking God for bringing us back to school safely and asking him to help us throughout the year.
