


Year 2 Newsletter

Hello parents and carers,

This week we have been identifying verbs and begun looking at adverbs and the suffix _ly. The children have been writing about garden activities and created their own Wanted posters for the Highway Rat.

In our Maths work this week we have focused on x2, x5 & x10 multiples and dividing by 2 and 5. The children have been tested on their x2 tables and

In RE, we have begun exploring celebrations and researching symbols, both religious and secular, that relate to Easter.

Our Science topic this half term is 'Materials and their Uses'. We have been exploring inside and outdoors to investigate what materials are used for, and explored why they are used for these purposes.
