The children have totally immersed themselves in this work, creating their beautiful poppies at home, making poppies in school to create a display in our Reflection Area, writing their moments in history for our whole school display and witnessing Year 6 delivering an amazing worship for this event. In class, the children have written the most fabulous letters in the persona of a soldier in the trench. For such young children to write on such a difficult subject has been lovely to see and they have produced fabulous results. We have decided to put them on a display to complement the history display in the corridor. Please take some time to read them during Parents' Evening next Thursday. The children have also been practising their recital of our Remembrance poem ready for our class service today. In our Maths we have been looking at the 4x tables and the relationship with the 2x tables. We have also been looking at sequences and working out the pattern and rule. In Science, we learnt the new vocabulary of reversible and irreversible. We used eggs and chocolate to investigate this and practised our scientific drawing. Mrs Morris has started looking at algorithms in Computing. In addition to our Remembrance worship in class this week, the children have found similarities and differences between the Bible and the Qur'an
