Can you draw and label a plant, including *roots, stem, leaf, flower* and explain the functions of each different part?

Perhaps you have been doing some gardening at home? Which creatures have visited the plants in your garden? Why? If you have any seeds or bulbs at home, you could plant them and see what happens over the next few weeks.

Writing/ Art - How about you write a diary this week, describing all the things you get up to. Write down your feelings, what you see if you go out for a walk, any games that you play or movies that you watch. Or, if you prefer, you could draw a picture of 'lockdown', perhaps draw all the people who are still working, cartoon versions of you and your family and the activities you are doing or even an abstract picture showing shapes and colours which you associate with this time.

PE - Don't forget to keep up your exercise. The weather is so beautiful so get outside and move in whichever way you like! You could dance, cycle, go on the trampoline, do laps around the garden Captain Tom Moore style or perhaps do some hula hooping or skipping. Set an obstacle course up and challenge yourself to complete it quicker each time you do it!!
