





LEARNING IN SCHOOL

English: We started a new unit looking at Puss in Boots. We have explored the wide variety of boots available and how all felines are similar yet different. We have generated lots of word banks which we shall use throughout the remainder of the unit.

Maths: We have used this week to focus on time. We have identified telling the time on both analogue and digital clocks as well as calculating how much time passes in different scenarios.

RE: We concluded our first unit of the term by investigating the Islamic Holy Book, the Qur'an.

Science: We applied our knowledge of separating and filtering mixtures by trying to make our 'sewage water' as clean as we could. We used a wide variety of equipment including measuring cylinders and filter paper.

History: We began our unit on Ancient Egypt by placing that civilization on a timeline.
