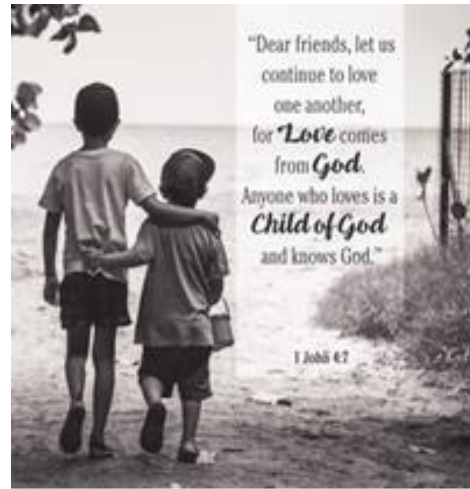
### This Week
