

Science: Changing Materials

- Explore what materials everyday objects are made from
- Collect and display materials and their uses
- Explore how materials can be changed – freezing water/lollies
- Explore and test materials – eg. sun hats and helmets
- Explore wet and dry sand – does it behave in the same way?

What if we didn't have materials we can change?

MC – How do different ethnic groups use materials?

Geography: Local coastal features

- Use maps, recognise features and follow simple routes.
- Physical and human features in our locality.
- Explore coastal features (Blackpool/Lytham St. Anne's) and related vocabulary.
- How has the coast/Blackpool changed?

How do our surroundings challenge us to learn and grow?

MC- Which countries do our families have cultural links with?

History: – Steam trains to Electric trains

- Significant history in the locality (Victorian Blackpool)
- Significant history in our own families
- Research a significant family member

Mathematics

Number and Place Value

- Count in steps of 2,3 and 5 from 0, and in tens from any number, forward and backward
- Read and write numbers to at least 100 in numerals and in words
- Recognise the place value of each digit in a two-digit number
- Compare and order numbers from 0 to 100

Addition and subtraction

- Solve problems with addition and subtraction including missing numbers

Geometry – properties of shapes

- Identify and describe the properties of 2-d shapes, including the number of sides and line symmetry in a vertical line
- Identify and describe the properties of 3-d shapes, including the number of edges, vertices and faces
- Identify 2-d shapes on the surface of 3-d shapes

Geometry – position and direction

- Rotation as a turn - quarter, half and three-quarter turns (clockwise and anti-clockwise)

Measurement

- Use rulers, scales, thermometers and measuring vessels
- Compare and sequence intervals of time

Statistics

- Compare and sort objects, numbers and common 2-d and 3-d shapes and everyday objects
- Interpret and construct simple pictograms, tally charts, block diagrams and simple tables
- Ask and answer simple questions by counting, sorting, totalling and comparing data

English

Story as a Theme

- Narratives written, based on film or picture books, with seaside and/or pirate themes. Ice-cream shop/pirate role play

Eg. The Jolly Rogers

Poems on a Theme

- Read poems using tone and intonation
- Collect favourite words and phrases
- Use common suffixes
- Write a 'seascape' sound poem

Explanations

- Features of explanation texts (non-fiction)
- Write an explanation text linked to a seaside process/activity eg. Rock making
- Instructions for making ice-cream/lollies
- Instructions for making sandcastle or lighthouse
