This week in Class...

Maths

This week the children have been practising arithmetic skills and looking at how to solve multi-step problems. We have also taken part in a Maths carousel day where the children moved around the classes and enjoyed some exciting activities!

English

We have continued reading our class novel and have focused on reading skills and finding evidence in the text. We have been thinking about the characters' feelings, thoughts and motives from their actions.

Across the Curriculum

In D.T. the children have been looking at the sugar content in different food items. They have also been looking at natural sugar vs refined sugar and the effect sugar has on our bodies. In R.E. we have been thinking about people who knew Jesus, such as Mary and the disciples. The children have been thinking about how these people would've felt about Jesus. Our Science lesson was about classifying animals into different groups and we created our own classification keys.
