Learning this Week

In our **English** work we have focused on the Simon Bartram story 'Bob and the Moontree Mystery'. The children have collected vocabulary and designed their own baby aliens and written character descriptions.

In **Mathematics** we have been collecting data and recording it in pictograms. We have used collected data to answer questions.
