## Learning This Week

This week in our maths work we have been sorting, ordering and counting coins. We have been adding amounts of money, calculating change and enjoying using online maths games to practise our money skills.

In English we have been reading information texts about astronauts and used these texts to answer questions.

Our Science has focused on seasonal changes and in RE we have shared the stories of Jesus healing the Ten Lepers and Blind Bartimaeus.
