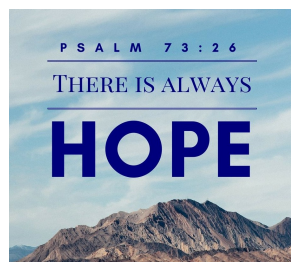
### Projects
