Class News

This week in Class 5 we have continued to fine tune our skills in Maths, Reading and Grammar. Our Maths has focused on reading and plotting co-ordinates in all four quadrants, finding missing points for given shapes as well as translating them. We have worked on our inference skills in Reading using a short text ironically named 'The Hottest Day'! Despite the current climate, the children were still able to remember that lovely feeling of a warm breeze and the sun on your skin. Grammar work has powered through a range of topics from pronouns to standard English – maybe you could ask your child to explain these to you? SATs week takes place between Monday 13th May and Thursday 16th May this year. I will be sending out an information sheet regarding the arrangements for this next week.

We have begun learning about the workings of the circulatory system in Science. Having learnt the function of the heart, we went on to investigate the effect of various exercise intensities on our heart rate. The children did very well working scientifically to take their own heart rates after different exercises.
