BISHOP'S HARVEST APPEAL 2020

For our Harvest Appeal this year, we are hoping to support Tearfund, a Christian charity passionate about ending poverty. Tearfund is changing lives in Ethiopia, working to set up solar powered wells which will bring clean water closer to communities. The children have been listening to the story of Orbisa, a mother of nine, who walks **TEN** miles each night through dangerous territory, to collect water for her family and livestock. But, hope is within reach!



We believe that we all have an amazing God given potential to create positive change so let's use it! Following discussions with members of The Ethos group and Extra Milers, it has been decided that every member of our school family will be tasked with walking **ten** laps of our school field (1 mile and collectively over 150 miles in total!) whilst carrying a bucket of water. We ask that your child collects sponsors for this event (in a safe and responsible way), and all money raised will help Tearfund provide crucial water supply and transform lives forever. Sponsor forms will be sent home with your child before half term and you will be informed of the date for the event in due course.
