Maths

We have been learning to calculate with fractions and practising our arithmetic skills with a range of calculations.

English

We have begun reading (and almost finished!) a new Class Novel: War of the Worlds. We have studied the author's description and written some descriptions of our own. We have also be practising the skill of skimming and scanning the text to find key information and evidence.

We have also completed some Maths and English assessments so I am able to help support the individual learning needs of every child.
