This Week...

This week the children have been settling into their classroom (which is new for our Year 3 children) and we have been getting to know each other. We have talked about what is the same in school and what is different due to the current situation. We have also been learning the key ways to stay safe in school: stay in our work spaces, wash hands frequently, use tissues to catch coughs and sneezes and try to avoid touching our faces. We have completed some English and Maths activities so I can begin to assess where the children are up to in their learning and then I am better equip to support them as we move forward! I have been so impressed with the attitude and behaviour of the children and the resilience they have shown in settling back in so far.



Next Week...

Maths

We will be looking at place value including ordering and comparing numbers. We will also be revisiting key skills which may have been missed while the children were off school. Additionally, we will be recapping and practising time tables. Our Maths lessons will include using lots of visual and concrete resources to help the children understand the concepts taught.

English

In English we will start our new Class Novel: George's Marvellous Medicine by Roald Dahl. We will be making predictions, exploring some of the characters and looking at the vocabulary used by the author.

Homework and Reading

Reading books will be sent out next week and homework will start the week after.
