This Week...

The children have been thinking about and describing the main characters as well as exploring American vocabulary in the story. Across the Curriculum

This week we have been researching some of the world's deadliest earthquakes in Geography. In Science we have been finding out why we have 'day' and 'night' and we have used touches and mini globes to demonstrate this. Our R.E. lesson looked at the 'Seder Plate' used during the Jewish festival of Passover; we explored the foods eaten and the children created their own plates to represent slavery and freedom. This week we have also used the running track to complete a 'Lea Mile' – the fresh air and exercise has been great for our minds and bodies!
