It was lovely to see so many parents attending.

Learning in Class

This week in our English activities we have enjoyed sharing the story 'The Snail and the Whale' by Julia Donaldson and two titles from the Mucky Minibeast book series – Worms and Snails. The children really enjoyed discovering lots of interesting facts about both of these. Did you know a worm has five hearts? A snail has thousands of teeth on its tongue! Next week we will be investigating Ants & Millipedes and Centipedes. What amazing facts will we discover?

In our maths work we have been focusing on addition – adding three single digit numbers, adding two-digit numbers and multiples of ten and adding two two-digit numbers. Next week we will focus on subtraction using base ten and pictorial representations.

In our RE work we have begun exploring the Easter story and in Science we have been exploring micro-habitats in our school grounds – collecting information and making observations.
