Maths

This week have revised the terms multiple, factor and prime number and have used this to help us calculate with fractions.

Don't Forget

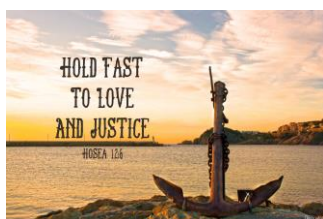
- Borwick Hall Medical form (3B) to be returned to school before next Friday 1st February please.
