In Year 1...

We have had a lovely start to the Half Term with everyone in Year 1 ready and enthusiastic to continue their learning. The children loved reading "The Runaway Pea" and writing simple sentences about the story.

This week we have moved onto using our sound mats to spell words. You should have a copy of the sound mat attached to the Year 1 Meet the Teacher notes.

Feel free to use the mat if your child would like to write at home too.

In Maths we have been looking at 1 more and 1 less. Some of the children have already "wowed" me with their counting in 10s and I have set the class the challenge this week of learning this at home.

Homework should have come home on Thursday to be returned on a Monday. You only need to complete one of the tasks each week if possible.

In Reading Records, we will be including a summary of some of the sounds and words we have focused on each week. These are helpful to recap with your child but we will not be testing them on these words in school.

We have been looking at place value and partitioning numbers to 100 in our maths lessons this week.

In English we have been exploring the story, 'The Way Home for Wolf' by Rachel Bright. The children have been collecting vocabulary and writing character descriptions.

In our Science we have begun our topic on 'Animals, including Humans' and we have been exploring animal groups and comparing the structure of two different animals.

In RE we have been looking at different Bibles. We discussed who might use them and the children have recognised that it is the very special holy book for Christians.
