### Year 4 Multiplication Check

When we return after half term, the children in year 4 will be completing their online Multiplication Check which is a statutory requirement for all Year 4 children across the country.

The children have been preparing for this in class **but would really benefit from additional practise at home over half term**. This could be through using TTRS regularly but, Hit the Button is probably even more useful at this stage as the children can access specific times tables. These need to be the 6x, 7x, 8x, 9x and 12x as these are the most difficult.
