### Hello Parents and Carers,

This week we have been exploring food poems in our English work and begun exploring the story 'The Highway Rat' by Julia Donaldson. We have also been collecting nouns, creating noun phrases and writing sentences to describe the food the rat loves.

In our Maths work we have begun a new topic on money. We have been counting pounds and pence and begun using £ and p notation. Next week, we will explore making amounts in different ways. This is always a tricky topic for the children and we would encourage you to look at real coins with your child and practise counting them and making amounts. Our role play area will become a shop to help the children explore totalling amounts and giving change.

In our RE topic we will be exploring Jesus, a friend to others and look at what makes a good friend. Our Science topic this half term is Seasonal change and Weather and the children will be collecting data and information.
