The **CHRISTIAN VALUE** award for **THANKFULNESS** goes to **Ellie**. She is always very thankful towards others.

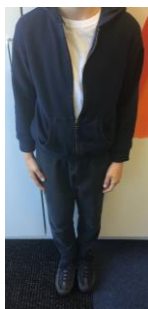
The **CURRICULUM** award goes to **Reilly** for excellent work in Science thinking through forces and friction.
