We used exciting language to describe the troll in our writing. In Maths we looked at solid 3D shapes. We learned that each side can be a different shape. We explored which are good for building and which are good for rolling. We printed the sides using paint to see what shapes they were. In RE we learned why the cross is so important to Christians. We talked about the different emotions we feel at different parts of the Easter Story.
