Reception

We have had a busy few weeks in Reception. We are thinking about how Harvest is celebrated across the world and how we can give thanks and share what we have. In Maths we have been comparing size and length and choosing a method to sort buttons, eg by shape, size or colour. We have been learning some facts about England and Wales and looking for them on a map. We have learned quite a few phonemes and are putting them together to read simple words. We are looking forward to sharing our skills with you when reading books start to come home!

Year 1

In English, we've been enjoying Harry the Happy Mouse. Jaxon did brilliantly, stepping into the role of the sad Frog, which gave us the chance to ask questions and understand using the character more deeply. In Maths, we've been exploring whole numbers and learning how they can be split into parts (the *part-whole model*). In RE, we learned about the Jewish festival of Sukkot and even made our own Sukkah shelters.
