This Week...

We have done some work on creating complex sentences in our English this week using the fables of the Fox and Grapes and the Lion and the Mouse. The children are enjoying learning the morals of the fables and are making links with the parables in the Bible. All the children love listening to the stories although many tell me that they are not reading regularly at home. Please keep up with reading at home; it is crucial to them making progress across the whole curriculum. In our Maths work we have been drilling down in our understanding of multiplication and the relationship between multiplication and division. The children must still be practising their times tables every week; Times Tables Rock Star is a fantastic way of doing this. We all enjoyed our Science, learning a lot of interesting facts about the skeleton, what it does, how it works and how it is AMAZING!

Next Week...

We shall be led by Year 6 children in our act of Remembrance on Monday. In class, we shall be continuing our work on Fables, planning out our own fables and using the stories we have heard as a model for our own writing. In our Maths work we shall be investigating sequencing, identifying sequences and continuing them. We shall continue with our work on the human body, investigating differences and celebrating our uniqueness. We are exploring People of God in our RE this half term and we are learning all about the Prophets and their calling by God. The children will be creating artwork to represent their understanding of what it is to be called by God.
