### Learning this Week

This week we have been focusing on place value, part-whole models and comparing numbers to 100 in our **Mathematics** work.

In **English** we have explored more stories with a wolf theme including our core story text – The Way Home for Wolf.

In our **Science** work we have recapped our knowledge on senses and explore life processes related to survival.

In **RE** we have explored ways in which we can thank God for his creation and help others. The children have also written some lovely thank you prayers.

### Learning next Week

Next week in our **Maths** work we will be focusing on numbers to 100 and tens and ones and using equipment to solve problems. In **English** we will be focusing on reading skills and using *and*, *but* and *or* to extend our sentences.

Our **Science** work will involve exploring senses in more depth and we will be investigating the effects of exercise on the body.

Our **topic** work will focus on the Harris Museum, the Cenotaph and the Flag Market exploring the architecture and history of these landmarks.

In our **RE** work we will be finding out more about how our food is produced and be finding out about the Diocesan Harvest Appeal for this year.
