### The last fortnight in class...

#### English

Last week, the children watched a short film entitled 'The Lighthouse'. They wrote their own versions of the story using the correct tense and structure. We have been focusing on including ambitious and descriptive vocabulary. This week we have started reading a new class novel: a children's version of the classic War of the Worlds by H. G. Wells.

#### Maths

In Maths we have been focusing on decimal numbers including rounding and calculating.

#### Across the Curriculum

We have started our new Science topic about Earth and Space. In R.E. the children have been thinking about the question 'Who is Jesus?' They have thought about various bible characters and how they may have responded to this question. In D.T. the children have started to prepare for our showcase afternoon. They have been learning about food safety and hygiene, equipment needed and food preparation techniques.
