There have been so many things to enjoy. Here are just a few of my personal favourites:-

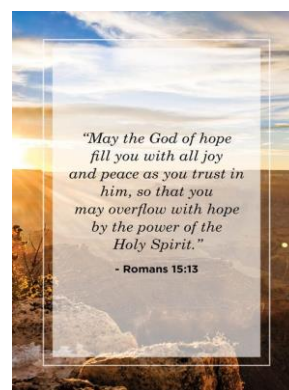
- our Christmas party and pantomime
