

A reminder that Our Harvest appeal is supporting the work of the **Mosamaria Trust**, a charity that works with those most in need in our link diocese of **The Free State, South Africa** looking after children who have been orphaned by the various illnesses associated with AIDS.

**Mosamaria** holds after school clubs which provide food and education for these children. Teaching through games and songs, they enrich school lessons and help with homework. They run sports programmes which are designed to develop leadership and teamwork skills while at the same time giving opportunity to discuss things as simple as good hygiene. **Mosamaria** supports and feeds some of the most vulnerable children in South Africa.
